We are recruiting people to become CAN-BIKE cycling instructors. We are looking for people who can make a three-year commitment to offer cycling courses in Thunder Bay. This fall, our maximum enrollment is 8 people.

CAN-BIKE is a national cycling skills training program created by the Canadian Cycling Association and Transport Canada. CAN-BIKE offers courses for cyclists of all ages and abilities.

In order to become a professional CAN-Bike cycling instructor, candidates must successfully complete two CAN-BIKE courses. With the Ontario Trillium Foundation's financial support, we are offering these courses at **no charge**. (The total value of these courses is over \$1000.00.) In addition, CAN-BIKE Instructors get paid to run CAN-BIKE cycling courses!

Participants must attend the following courses:

CAN-BIKE 2 Course: September 16, 17, and 18 - 8:30 am to 4:30 pm

CAN-BIKE Instructor Course (part 1): October 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> - 8:30 am to 4:30 pm

CAN-BIKE Instructor Course (part 2): October 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> - 8:30 am to 4:30 pm

Our ultimate goal is to develop a National Examiner located in Northwestern Ontario. Instructors require three years of experience teaching CAN-Bike courses to become National Examiners. National Examiners are in high demand and are paid to teach CAN-Bike courses and train instructors throughout Canada.

If you would like to become a professional cycling instructor, please submit your resume and cover letter to EcoSuperior by September 10, 2011. Community service, teaching, and cycling experience are considered assets.
