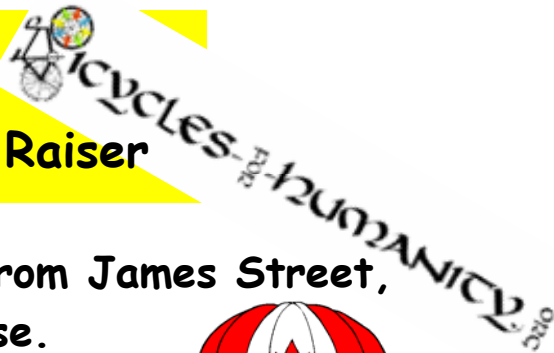


# 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Mini-GO-Ride
